

PROTECT OUR COMMUNITIES — FIX FUKUSHIMA NOW

What nuclear critics have consistently warned about over the years as a nightmare scenario is happening right now at Fukushima—a loss of containment and an uncontrolled meltdown in three nuclear reactors. A fourth reactor's spent fuel pool, containing 5000 Hiroshima-sized bombs worth of extremely radioactive material, is precariously situated on its top floor, 100 feet above the ground. Removal of this dangerous material is so difficult that it may take years to complete at the current rate of work.

Until that spent fuel pool is safely emptied, there is the possibility that another strong earthquake may result in massive, worldwide radioactive contamination.

Japan has a responsibility to the international community to enlist outside expertise and assistance in mitigating the dangerous spent fuel pool crisis at Unit #4 as soon as possible. The United States has a responsibility to its citizens and the world to provide such assistance, and to enjoin the international community to act on a "global emergency" basis.

We are asking you to pass a resolution, proclamation, or letter of endorsement, taking the position that the current situation in Fukushima is so potentially catastrophic that all levels of government and leadership throughout our society should proactively call for U.S. and international support and assistance to Japan:
